2026 ITINERARY

DAY 1 - WEDNESDAY, JUNE 17

ARRIVE TO BELGRADE

Arrive to Belgrade airport and head to the hotel. In the evening, we'll meet and greet at the hotel. Enjoy dinner and drinks with your fellow travelers. Overnight in Belgrade. (D)

DAY 2 - THURSDAY, JUNE 18

BELGRADE

Begin with a morning sightseeing tour of Belgrade. We'll drive through Republic Square and visit St. Sava Temple, the largest Orthodox church in the world. We'll continue with a tour of the Nikola Tesla Museum and Kalemegdan Fortress, set where the Sava and Danube Rivers meet. We'll enjoy Knez Mihajlova Street for some lunch, shopping and free time before an entertaining dinner along the Danube River. Overnight in Belgrade. (B,D)

DAY 3 - FRIDAY, JUNE 19

BELGRADE - TOPOLA- BELGRADE

We will drive to Topola and visit Oplenac and the Mausoleum of the Serbian Royal House of Karadjordje. In the afternoon we'll visit a local winery and taste through the areas wines. We will return to Belgrade for dinner in the Bohemian district of Skadarlija. (B,D)

DAY 4 - SATURDAY, JUNE 20

BELGRADE - NOVI SAD - BELGRADE

A day tour in Novi-Sad will take us around many city sights including the Petrovaradin Fortress where you will be able to overlook the entire city. We'll finish with a wonderful, wine paired dinner at a local winery before heading back to Belgrade. (B,D)

DAY 5 - SUNDAY, JUNE 21

BELGRADE - ZAGREB

Today we'll make our way to Zagreb, Croatia with a couple stops along the way. After a few hours into the drive, we'll enjoy wine tasting and mezze in Kutjevo followed by dinner just outside the city at a local farm. (B,D)

DAY 6 - MONDAY, JUNE 22

ZAGREB

A morning sightseeing tour of Zagreb includes views of the historic upper town, St. Mark's Church and St. Catherine's Church, Mirogoj Park Cemetery, the Zagreb Cathedral, parliament building, and government palace. There will be plenty of time to explore all the shops, restaurants and cafes this picturesque city has to offer. We'll join back up for dinner. (B,D)

DAY 7 - TUESDAY, JUNE 23

ZAGREB - SLOVENIA- ZAGREB

Journey to Ljubljana where we will see sights of the Old City Center on a walking tour. Highlights include the open-air central market, the three bridges, Baroque Town Hall and Robba's Fountain. After, we'll enjoy some free time for lunch and shopping before returning to Zagreb for dinner and the night. (B,D)

DAY 8 - WEDNESDAY, JUNE 24

ZAGREB - ZADAR- SPLIT

Journey to Split where we will stop in Zadar for a seaside lunch and brief city tour to see the Sea Organ, Port Gate and church of St. Anastasia. We'll continue on to Split where we will have dinner at the hotel. (B,L,D)

DAY 9 - THURSDAY, JUNE 25

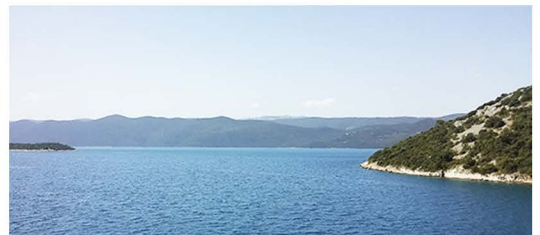
SPLIT

A free day to rest, enjoy shopping and exploring all that the Old City has to offer. In the evening we will embark on a beautiful cruise on the Adriatic Sea before dinner. Overnight in Dubrovnik. (B,D)

DAY 13 - MONDAY, JUNE 29
